END OF FINANCIAL YEAR

Reports sent to all members last week outlined our income and expenditure statement for year ended June 30, 2019.

These reports covering full financial year, outlined:

Total income - \$674,398

Total Expenditure - \$662,031

Profit for year ending June 30, 2019 = \$12,367

Any profit received goes back to members. These funds contribute to the ongoing coordination of future events.







FACTS & FIGURES

Our total bank balance as at October 24, 2019 is \$449,860.

Greatly exceeding our current liabilities, this is inflated due to the recently received income from memberships and entry to AGM, all prior to these expenses being paid.
